From Decatur — Go west on (I-72 / US-51) Take EXIT114 toward MECHANICSBURG/BUFFALO. Turn left onto BUFFALO-MECHANICSBURG RD/CR-19 S. Keep LEFT at the fork to go on BUFFALO-MECHANICSBURG RD/CR-19. Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto W. MAIN ST/CR-33. Turn RIGHT onto S. CHURCHST/CR-19. Continue to follow CR-19. Turn RIGHT onto DARNELL RD/CR-12.

From Springfield — Go east on (I-72 / US-36). At exit 104, turn RIGHT onto CR-12 [Mechanicsburg Rd.]. Keep RIGHT (South) at the fork onto CR-12 [S Tower Rd.]. Keep straight on CR-12 name changes to Darnell Rd.

From Taylorville — Go North-West on SR-29 [W Springfield Rd.] 11.4 miles Turn RIGHT onto E FRANKLIN ST/CR-21. Turn LEFT onto CR-23/S CAMPBELL ST. Continue to follow CR-23. Turn LEFT onto E 2675N RD/CR-2. Turn RIGHT onto CR-3/N 730E RD. CR-3/N 730E RD becomes ROBY RD/CR-19. Turn LEFT onto DARNELL RD/CR-12.

General Camp Rules

1. No tobacco, alcoholic beverage, illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia, pornography, weapons, or fireworks are allowed on the campground. The only exception shall be camp sponsored fireworks under the direction of the Camp Director or Camp Caretaker.
2. Profanity will not be tolerated on the campground.
3. During camps or retreats male and female campers (*children & teen*), are not allowed in each others rooms.
4. During camps or retreats; males and females shall not occupy the same camper's room or R.V. unless they are a married couple or members of the same family or children in the care of an adult, as recognized by the Church of the Nazarene.
5. Pets are not allowed on the campground, except in R.V. area.
6. Any person or persons that cause damage to property or facilities shall be responsible for the repair and/or cost of repair involved. Parents/ guardians shall be responsible for the acts of their minors.
7. The pond is not patrolled by a lifeguard, and is considered unsafe and off limits for wading or swimming.
8. Dress is subject to the Biblical standard of Christian modesty. Undergarments should not be visible at any time. Swimwear should be worn only for designated activities. Requirements are full one piece suits for females or two piece suits will be allowed if a colored t-shirt is worn over the suit. Boxer trunk style or cut off jeans is the styles for males.
9. Shoes must be worn at all times.
10. All vehicles shall observe a 10 MPH speed limit while on the campground.
